- All students need to bring a drink bottle. We have water coolers to refill bottles throughout the day.
- Students, SLSOs and parent helpers run our Breakfast Club each morning.

Students will practise what it is like to come to 'big school' and get to meet the teachers and other students. Further details about Kindergarten Orientation will be emailed to you.






