**Silent Letters**

<b>Silent 'b'</b>	Comes after 'm' or before 't', both at the end of a word.	-mb (lamb) -bt (debt)
<b>Silent 'k'</b>	Comes as the first letter in a word.	kn- (know)
<b>Silent 'w'</b>	Comes as the first letter in a word, followed by 'r', or by 'h'. Comes after 's'.	wr- (write) wh- (who) sw- (sword)
<b>Silent 't'</b>	Comes in the middle of words with '-stle' or '-sten'.	-stle (whistle) -sten (listen)
<b>Silent 'l'</b>	when '-al' is followed by 'm' or 'f'	-alm (calm) -alf (half)

  - the babies are **ducklings**



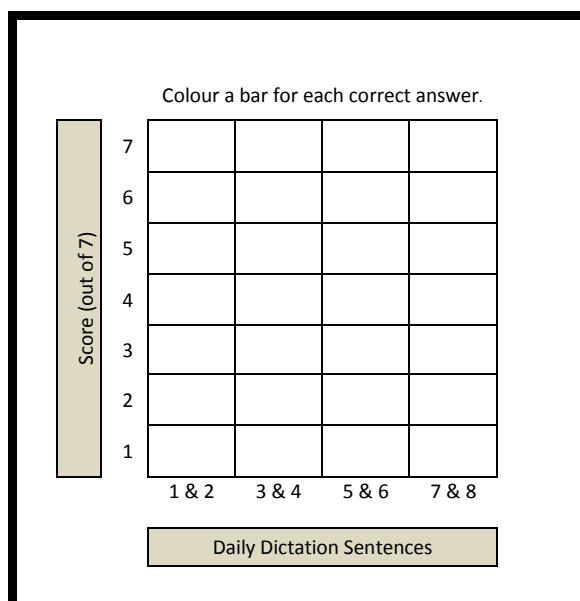
