Silent 'k'	Comes as the first letter in a word.	kn-	(know)
Silent 'w'	Comes as the first letter in a word, followed by 'r', or by 'h'. Comes after 's'.	wr- wh- sw-	(write) (who) (sword)
Silent 't'	Comes in the middle of words with '-stle' or '-sten'.	-stle -sten	(whistle) (listen)
Silent 'l'	when '-al' is followed by 'm' or 'f'	-alm -alf	(calm) (half)


